EASE Project focus areas

- ❑ Deployment of District Energy Officers in Dedza and Balaka
- ❑ Construction/Installation of Energy Hubs.
 - ✓ To provide reliable and affordable electricity through wired connections
 - ✓ To be used for production use of energy(PUE)
 - ✓ An opportunity for local income development for businesses (PUE) and spur economic development

BACKGROUND

Blueprinting of DEO

- Noted gap in decentralized energy
 - ✓ Community Energy Planning missing in VAP/DDP
 - ✓ Dept. of Energy- centralized than decentralized
 - ✓ High failure rate of energy projects
 - ✓ Erratic funding for energy related interventions

Key Project Activities

Training of 170 frontline officers in mainstreaming energy in Village Area Planning process (VAP) process



Tailored presentations to 280 officers from different sectors at district level

Project Activities

- >29 Backstopping meetings – ADC, VDC, communities and energy scrapping



Project Activities

- **Training of 20 local technicians (1 in every TA) to support RE systems in there community**



- **Training of 342 entrepreneurs and linkages made for distribution of renewable energy technologies**

- **4 Awareness campaign on renewable energy standards, policy and regulatory frameworks.**
